Competitions Policy

Every now and then Mr James Maths Tuition will run competitions, these competitions are usually to win prizes. Competitions will be posted out using the Me James Maths Tuition social media platforms, these platforms will also be used as advertising.

When a competition is being run, there will be specific requirements which need to be met in order for the claimant to win the prize, for example, if a competition is run to win a specific prize, they may be asked to like and share the Mr James Maths Tuition Facebook page, and comment Maths underneath the advertisement to be in with the chance of winning the prize.

All steps need to be followed in order to be in with the chance of winning the prize, failure to follow all of the steps will result in the claimant being removed from the prize draw.

All of the conditions, including the draw date will be clearly identified on all promotional materials.

On the date in which the draw is to take place, the draw will be recorded using an online screen recording software, as well as a spreadsheet document (Or similar) with all of the people who have successfully followed all of the steps and who have qualified for the prize draw.

Once the winner has been announced, they will be contacted using a contact method which has been specified by the customer, this will usually be using the platform in which the competition is advertised, for example, if a winner wins a competition on Facebook, they will be contacted via Facebook messenger and will be required to provide a delivery address, contact number and suitable time for the prize to be delivered.

The claimant will be required to sign a document claiming that they have received the prize and that they are happy. This document will be sent electronically via email and will require the claimant to sign and electronically return the document before the prize can be claimed, please note that failure to sign the document will result in the claimant not being able to claim the prize.

Once a competition has been drawn, the claimant will have 28 days in which to claim their prize, failure to claim the prize within the allocated time will result in the competition being void, meaning that the claimant will lose the prize, this will often result in the same competition being re advertised with an extension to the competition close date.

There are a range of different prizes which can be won and the same condition applies despite the prize.

If a customer wins gift vouchers provided by Mr James Maths Tuition, these can be redeemed and used on any product or service offered by Mr James Maths Tuition, these vouchers will last for a period of 6 months and cannot be exchanged for cash, these vouchers do not have any monetary value.

Please note that if a competition is being entered by an individual, only the person who has entered the competition will be eligible to claim the prize.
